# PA TRAFFIC LAW REFRESH

A Message  
from the  
Chairman  
& CEO

Before the busy summer travel season begins, I'd like to remind you of some Pennsylvania state traffic safety laws designed to keep you and your families safe:

**Automated speed enforcement** came to Pennsylvania in 2018 and may be used only when a work zone is active. This is part of a 5-year pilot program and includes active work zones on interstates under the jurisdiction of PennDOT and interstates and freeways under the jurisdiction of the Turnpike Commission. Prior to approaching the cameras, there will be two warning signs that notify of the camera being used in the work zone. Drivers going more than 11 miles per hour over the posted speed limit in a work zone are subject to the following penalties: first offense is a written warning, second offense is a \$75 fine, and the third or following offense is a \$150 fine.

**Pennsylvania's "Steer Clear" Law** was enacted to help prevent injuries and save lives of first responders. It requires drivers to move over or slow down when they encounter an emergency scene, traffic stop, or disabled vehicle. Drivers must move over or slow down for all responders, including police, fire and ambulance crews, as well as stopped tow trucks and maintenance vehicles. In 2018, a similar regulation went into effect to protect trash/recycling trucks, mail trucks or roadside assistance truck workers. Drivers must slow down and move one lane away (if possible) when approaching trash/recycling truck, mail truck or roadside assistance truck workers.

**"Turn Around, Don't Drown"** is a reminder that motorists may not drive past, around or through a sign or traffic-control device closing a road or highway due to an existing or hazardous condition. This is a summary offense and is punishable by a fine of \$250. If the violation results in the use of services of a first responder or emergency medical or rescue personnel (including a tow service), the fine doubles to \$500 - and the driver is responsible for all the emergency response costs.

**"Right-of-way for pedestrians in crosswalks"** is a state law mandating that when a traffic-control device is not in place or not in operation, the driver of a vehicle will yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian crossing the roadway at an intersection with a marked or unmarked crosswalk, a pedestrian crossing at a light, a pedestrian who is accompanied by a guide dog/carrying a white cane or who is crossing at alleys, driveways or sidewalks. This is a summary offense and is punishable by a fine of \$50.

As you travel throughout our state and beyond this summer, please stay safe and obey these - and all - traffic laws.

# KEEP YOUR PETS SAFE IN AN EMERGENCY

Pets were one of the top reasons Hurricane Katrina survivors gave for not evacuating the 2005 disaster, according to the Fritz Institute. Nonetheless, the ASPCA reports some 250,000 dogs and cats were either killed in the devastating storm or left without shelter.

After many disasters, thousands of household pets are left to fend for themselves and are lost, injured or killed, which is why it's essential to have an evacuation plan that includes your pets. AAA suggests some steps you can take now that will keep your "fur babies" and other beloved pets safe in an emergency.

**Apply a pet rescue alert sticker to your window.** These stickers can be purchased for dogs, cats, birds or multi-pet households. They alert rescuers and first responders there might be animals trapped inside.

**Create an emergency supply kit.** This kit should include at least three days' worth of food and water; medications and medical records (in a waterproof container); garbage bags; a leash, a crate or carrier; a picture of your pet in case you become separated; and anything else necessary for your pet's survival.

**Microchip your dog or cat.** Even an ID tag or collar can be lost or pulled off. A microchip might be the only way to be certain your pet can be identified during a disaster. If you've changed addresses or phone numbers, be sure to update this information assigned to your

pet's microchip. Otherwise, rescuers might not be able to contact you in the event your pet is lost.

**Investigate places for your pets to stay.** Because pets are not always allowed in emergency shelters, you should have a list of places your pet can stay in case of a natural disaster. A pet shelter, a pet-friendly hotel, and the homes of relatives or friends outside the area are all potential places where your pet could be sheltered.

**Bring your animals inside.** When you hear that a storm or disaster is on its way, make sure your pets are in the house close to you. Dogs and cats can get confused and become disoriented during difficult times and might try to run away.

**Contain your pets.** Put dogs in a room with the door closed and put cats in a carrier. The sound of thunder or the smell of smoke can frighten animals, and they might disappear under beds or in other parts of the house, making them difficult to find in a hurry.

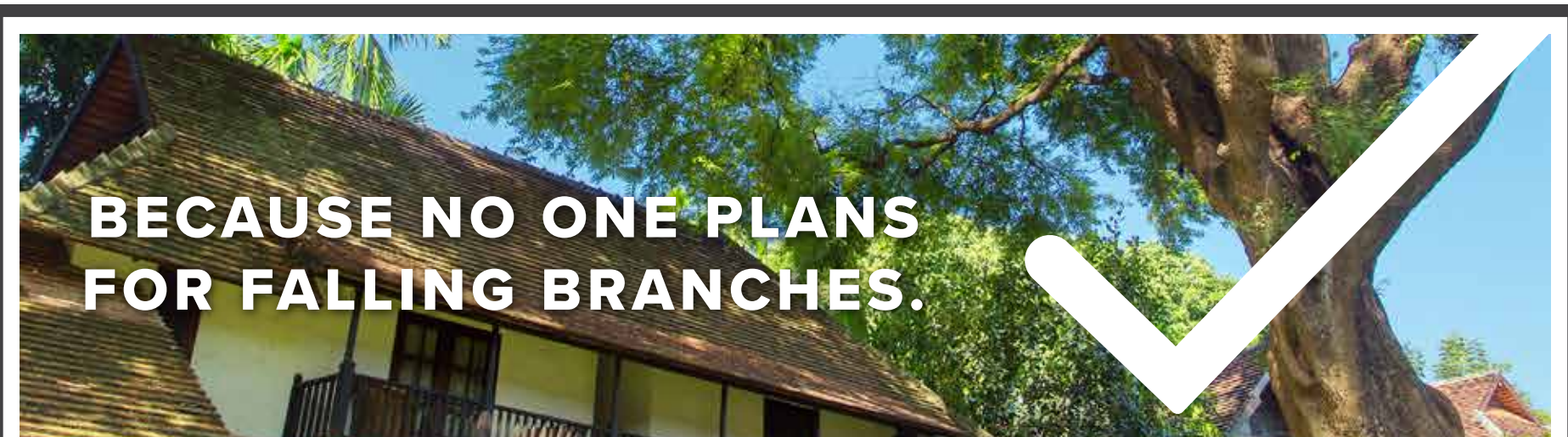
**Make sure birds and small animals are secure.** If you have a bird, try to get it into a



cage, and make sure that its leg band, if it wears one, is properly in place. For pets like mice, hamsters, lizards, and guinea pigs, the best thing is to latch them into their cages, so they can't escape.

**Establish a buddy system.** Arrange to exchange keys and information with a friend who also has a pet. That way, you can check on each other's houses and pets in case there's an emergency when one of you can't make it home.

Pets are an important part of some 85 million American homes, according to the 2017-2018 National Pet Owners Survey conducted by the American Pet Products Association. Make sure your pets and the rest of your family are covered. ## GOT A MOTORCYCLE? GET COVERED

*Increase in motorcycling sparks need for specialty insurance*

The number of U.S. households with motorcycles is growing, according to the Motorcycle Industry Council.

That means if you own one of the roughly 13 million motorcycles parked in garages or outside homes across the county, you'll need to take one more important thing with you on the road to keep you and your prized machine protected: specialty insurance.

If you prefer to travel on two wheels, it's important your insurance coverage is along for the ride. Specialty insurance through AAA offers peace of mind and protects your property.

Motorcycle households rose to a record 8 percent of U.S. households in 2018, an increase of more than 1.5 million homes since 2014, according to the Motorcycle Industry Council, which released its latest owner survey in January.

Motorcycles, as well as collector cars and boats, are generally not covered under standard auto or homeowners policies. Specialty policies offer broader coverage and options, specialized claims handling and customer service, and sometimes, additional

discounts for mature riders, completing training courses and memberships in rider associations or clubs.

Here is a quick primer on insurance products for motorcycles and other specialty vehicles:

- **Motorcycle insurance** offers replacement cost coverage and travel loss reimbursement, and might also include coverage for permanently attached accessories, safety apparel and helmets.
- **Collector vehicle insurance** covers antiques, street rods, classics, collector motorcycles, muscle cars, vintage race cars, kit cars, military vehicles, new exotics, tractors, custom cars and fire engines. Restorations in process, harder-to-place autos (such as Cobras), and collector trucks also may be eligible.
- **Watercraft insurance** policies cover various types of boats: powerboat, sport-fisher, sailboat, mid-performance boat, high-performance boat, bass boat, pontoon



boat, ski boat, hovercraft, trawler, houseboat, airboat and personal watercraft. Discounts on watercraft insurance policies might be available based on watercraft-ownership experience.

# SIMPLE STEPS TO SWIMMING SAFETY

More than 3,200 people drown each year in the U.S., according to the Centers for Disease Control. Drowning is also one of the leading causes of unintentional death in children between the ages of 1 and 9. Many of these fatalities occur even with supervision.

When warmer weather arrives, it's great to beat the heat in a pool. But pool owners and their family and friends should be aware of basic pool safety tips to make sure swimming is safe and fun for everyone.

## Have proper pool equipment

- Use a safety cover when your pool is not in use. Pool covers should tightly cover the entire pool so children or pets cannot slip underneath.
- Surround your pool with a fence or other barrier. The Consumer Product Safety Commission recommends securing your pool with a 4-foot-high fence or barrier with a self-closing, self-latching gate.
- Keep your pool clean and clear, and keep children away from pool filters and other

mechanical devices. The suction from these devices can injure a swimmer and even hold someone under water.

- Keep lifesaving equipment nearby. Life rings, floats or a reaching pole should be easily accessible.

## Learn and teach water safety skills

- Keep children under supervision at all times. Have inexperienced swimmers swim with an adult in the pool and wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved vest.
- Limit alcohol use. The CDC reports that alcohol is involved in 70 percent of all teen and adult deaths associated with water recreation. Alcohol negatively impacts balance, coordination and judgment. These effects are heightened by sun exposure and heat.
- Regularly check the pool area for any potential accident hazards. Glass bottles, toys and electric devices, such as radios and fans, can pose tripping or electrical hazards.



- Don't leave toys or floats in the pool when it's not in use. Kids may fall into the pool trying to reach them.
- Take CPR and first aid training or refresh your training if it has been awhile. Those trainings save lives every year.

Contact your insurance company. Let your insurance agent know if you have a pool to make sure you have the right coverage.

# GRILL SAFELY THIS BARBECUE SEASON

It's grilling season — finally, but before firing up your grill, consider some important information and tips from AAA for safe summer barbecues.

According to the U.S. Fire Administration, some 5,700 grill fires take place on residential properties every year. Most are caused by malfunctioning gas grills. These fires cause an average of \$37 million in damage annually to properties, structures and possessions, including gazebos, sheds and lawn furniture. And thousands of people visit emergency rooms every year because they've burned themselves while grilling.

Before you barbecue, take a few minutes to review grilling safety tips and to ensure your equipment is working properly.

## Safe barbecuing tips:

- Read and follow the owner's manual.
- Place your grill at least 10 feet away from walls and deck railings to prevent fires from igniting buildings. Keep your grill away from decorations, such as hanging plants and umbrellas.
- Never grill indoors or in confined areas;

charcoal grills produce carbon monoxide fumes that are fatal in unventilated areas.

- Keep a fire extinguisher nearby and know how to use it.
- Never leave a grill burning unattended.
- Grease can cause flare-up fires. Keep your grill clean by removing grease and fat build-up from the grill and grill trays.
- If the flame on your grill goes out, turn the grill and gas off. Wait at least 15 minutes before relighting and always make sure your grill lid is open before igniting.

## Grill maintenance and storage:

- When setting up at the start of grilling season, check grill hoses for cracks, holes and blockages. Blockages caused by food drippings or insects can be cleared with a wire or pipe cleaner.
- Run a soap solution — one part liquid soap, one part water — along hoses and at connections. If the solution bubbles, then there is a gas leak that needs repair.
- Store propane tanks outside and away from your home. Always check to ensure that valves are turned off.



## What your insurance covers:

Following the tips above may help prevent a grill fire spreading to your home, but if a fire does occur, a standard homeowners policy typically covers the following:

- Damage to the primary residence
- Damage to personal possessions, such as tables or lawn chairs
- Damage to insured structures on your property, such as sheds or gazebos
- Injuries to a guest, under the liability portion of the policy

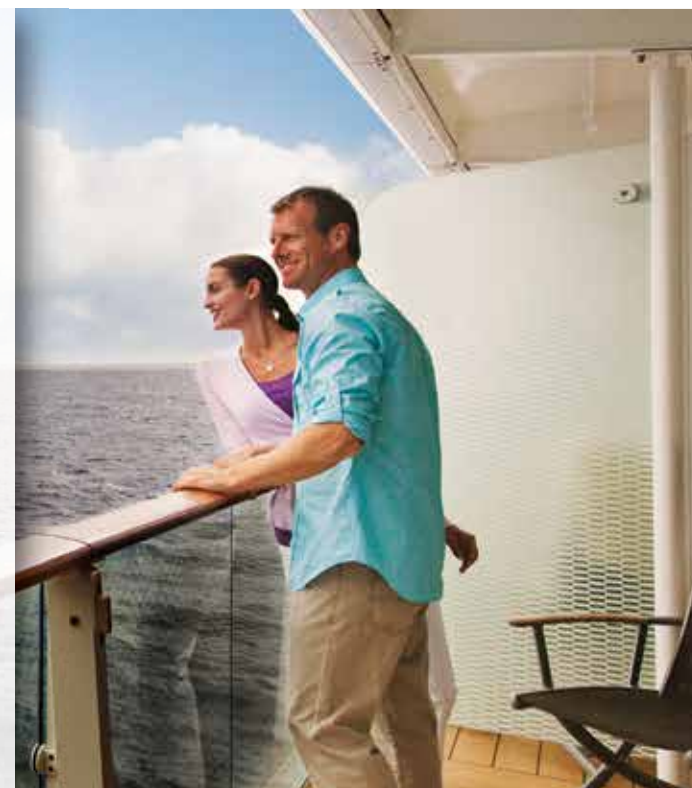

### **Zoëtry Agua Punta Cana** – Punta Cana, Dominican Republic

This high-end resort in Uvero Alto may be small, but its features and luxury are definitely mighty. It's only got 96 suites, but plenty of those are swim-up suites that line a long serpentine pool.

### **Iberostar Rose Hall** – Montego Bay, Jamaica

# HIGH MILEAGE: DRIVING IN THE U.S. IS ON THE RISE

If you think you're spending more time in your car, you're right. All Americans are spending more time driving, according to the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety's latest American Driving Survey — an additional 20 minutes per week on average, an 8 percent increase from five years ago.

The most recent survey examined data from 2014-2017, the latest available. The amount of time driving per day increased, with U.S. drivers spending nearly an hour (51 minutes) behind the wheel. The average number of daily miles driven was 31.5, more than a 5 percent increase since 2014.

In total, Americans drive 71 billion miles each year. Each week, drivers travel more than 220 miles, averaging out to 11,498 miles for all Americans each year. That's the equivalent of making two round-trip drives from San Francisco to Washington, D.C.

There are several factors contributing to the increases, including higher vehicle ownership, lower gas prices and aging highway infrastructure, which can contribute to more traffic delays.

One negative implication of more time behind the wheel is that it can equate to

greater chances of a crash. "The more time drivers spend behind the wheel, the greater their exposure to risks on the roadway," said Dr. David Yang, executive director for the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. "Longer time behind the wheel could lead to issues such as fatigue, distraction, and impatience for drivers, which are all contributing factors for vehicle crashes. Drivers need to stay alert and focused on the key task at hand, driving. This can save your life and the lives of your passengers and people with whom you share the road."

The AAA Foundation conducts the American Driving Survey to better understand driving habits, and subsequently, exposure to traffic risks.

AAA recommends that drivers on longer trips take breaks every two hours or 100 miles. And it's important for drivers to avoid distractions such as cellphones no matter how much time they spend behind the wheel.

#### Other findings from the American Driving Survey:

- Men drive 27 percent more miles than women.

- People who are married or living with a partner spend at least 12 percent more time driving than those who are not.
- Drivers age 75 or older are spending, on average, 34.8 minutes a day driving — a 23 percent increase from 2014-2015.
- Drivers in the West spend the most time driving (58.9 minutes per day), followed by drivers in the Northeast (51.1 minutes), South (49.9 minutes) and Midwest (44.5 minutes).
- The number of Midwestern people who reported driving has dropped 3 percent, while the number of drivers in the Northeast, South and West increased or remained the same.

The new results are part of the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety's American Driving Survey, which reveals the driving habits of the American public. The survey data are from a representative sample of 11,804 drivers who provided information about their driving on randomly selected days between January 1, 2014 and December 31, 2017.

# TEEN-DRIVER INVOLVED CRASHES KILL 10 PEOPLE A DAY DURING 100 DEADLIEST DAYS

More than 1,050 people were killed in crashes involving a teen driver in 2016 during the 100 Deadliest Days, the period between Memorial Day and Labor Day when teen crash deaths historically climb. That is an average of 10 people per day — a 14 percent increase compared to the rest of the year, according to data analyzed by the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. As school lets out for summer, AAA stresses the importance of preparing and educating inexperienced teen drivers for some of the most dangerous driving days of the year.

Speed and nighttime driving are significant factors contributing towards the number of crashes, and subsequently fatalities, involving teen drivers during the 100 Deadliest Days (statistics based on 2016 NHTSA FARS data as analyzed by the AAA Foundation).

## Nighttime Driving

Thirty-six percent of all motor vehicle fatalities involving teen drivers occurred between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Data shows a 22 percent increase in the average number of nighttime crashes per day involving teen drivers during the 100 Deadliest Days compared to the rest of the year.

## Speeding

Speeding is a factor in 29 percent of all motor vehicle deaths involving a teen driver. A AAA survey of driving instructors found that speeding is one of the top three mistakes teens make when learning to drive.

## Distractions

Distraction plays a role in nearly six of 10 teen crashes, four times as many as official estimates based on police reports. The top distractions for teens include talking to other passengers in the vehicle and interacting with a smartphone.

In preparation for the dangerous summer driving period, AAA encourages parents to educate their teens and themselves about risky driving behavior. Keep teen drivers safe with these tips:

- Discuss with teens early and often the dangers of risky driving situations, such as speeding and nighttime driving.
- Teach by example and minimize your own risky behavior when behind the wheel.
- Set rules against driving with teen passengers and restrict their teens from riding as a passenger with another teen driver.
- Restrict night driving by not letting teens drive after 9:00 or 10:00 p.m. unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Make a parent-teen driving agreement that

sets family rules for teen drivers. Consider setting driving limits that are stronger than a state's law, and enforce those limits.

**TeenDriving.AAA.com** has a variety of tools, including licensing and state law information, to help prepare parents and teens for not only the dangerous summer driving season, but also all year long. The site also features new interactive widgets highlighting teen driving risks, as well as a social host quiz. Strengthening teen driving laws to increase roadway safety is a top priority for AAA. The Association's advocacy efforts are helping to protect teens by working to pass graduated driver licensing laws, including seat belt requirements, wireless device bans and nighttime driving and passenger restrictions, in states across the country.

# THE DANGERS OF MULTIPLE MEDICATIONS IN OLDER DRIVERS

*Some commonly prescribed drugs can increase crash risks by up to 300 percent*

It's not just alcohol and illegal drugs that can impair driving — so can legally prescribed medications, taken alone or in combination with each other.

Almost half of adults 65 and older report using seven or more medications while remaining active drivers, according to new research from the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. Nearly 20 percent of older drivers are using medications that have very limited therapeutic benefit, pose excess harm, or both. Drugs like these are called potentially inappropriate medications, or PIMs. Most of them, such as benzodiazepines and first-generation antihistamines, are known to cause impairing effects such as blurred vision, confusion, fatigue or lack of coordination. They can increase a driver's risk for a crash by up to 300 percent.

The research is from AAA's groundbreaking multiyear LongROAD study. The project is one of the largest and most comprehensive databases available on senior drivers, supporting in-depth research on senior driving and mobility to better understand risks and develop effective countermeasures. Previous research from the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety found that fewer than 18 percent of older drivers report ever receiving a warning from their health care provider about how their prescriptions impact driving safety.

Considering the large number of medications used by older drivers, AAA urges seniors and their families to fully understand what doctors are prescribing and potential impairing effects:



- **Come prepared:** Write down any prescribed or over-the-counter medications you take and bring that list with you to every medical appointment. Don't forget to include vitamins or supplements.
- **Ask questions:** Find out about potential side effects or interactions that could affect your driving.
- **Discuss alternatives:** There are often ways to reduce risks through alternative medications, or changing the doses or the timing of the doses.

To learn more about their medications, drivers can use AAA's Roadwise Rx. This free online tool helps drivers and their families understand common side effects of prescription drugs, over-the-counter medications and herbal supplements. It also flags interactions between these medications that can impact safety behind the wheel. Print the free list and report, then discuss the confidential results with your doctor or pharmacist to learn how to mitigate possible crash risks.
